

Administrative Vice-Chairperson Report for March 24th, 2010 Board Meeting

ByLaws: Walter and David are reviewing the current VSI ByLaws. David has reviewed all current BSI Bylaws in comparison to the USA-S recommended ByLaws templates. David, Walter, and Mary will meet to go over these comparisons and draft language for the final draft of the recommended ByLaws changes. Such VSI ByLaws recommended amendments will be proposed to the September 2010 VSI House of Delegates meeting for review and vote of approval; AFTER such bylaws amendments have been reviewed by VSI Board Members.

Safety: Steve Woolfolk has done a nice job authoring the Safety Tip of the Month. There were some concerns about air quality at some of the 2009-2010 Short Course VSI meets. Safety injury -incident reports should be completed by any athlete, coach, official, or spectator who was adversely impacted by air quality at a VSI sanctioned meet.

High School - The support of VSI , through the initial up-front purchase of high school rule books, was a very nice gesture in support of VHSL high school swimming. High School Swimming coach / official Clinics were well attended this year. Clinics were held in different parts of the state to minimize the driving time for all coaches and officials. There will be at least two clinics in the Fall of 2010 committed to review of Diving Judging in high school.
