

VSI ATHLETE HONOR CODE & PARENT CONSENT

Proper behavior has a positive influence on individual and team performance. The following Code of Conduct establishes minimum standards that will be administered by Virginia Swimming Inc. and selected Team Manager. Upon notification of any violation of the Code of Conduct, the Team Manager shall promptly investigate the circumstances of the violation and determine what disciplinary action, if any, shall be taken. All athletes and athlete's parents/guardians are required to acknowledge and support this code.

The undersigned athlete member participating in the 2014 Eastern Zone Long Course Age Group Championship Meet agrees to abide by the standards of conduct outlined below. Any additional guidelines regarding conduct will be presented at team meetings and/or posted to the VSI website Zone Team Page.

- All athletes are required to follow the direction of the staff members. 1.
- All athletes are required to attend all team meetings, training sessions, and events unless excused 2. by the coaching staff or team manager.
- All athletes must adhere to established curfews. 3.
- All athletes will not possess or use alcohol, tobacco, or any illegal or banned substances. 4.
- All athletes will follow guidelines established for mixed company (male and female) in the 5. athlete's room. No male and female athlete pair shall be in an athlete's room alone under any circumstances.
- All athletes will refrain from all illegal or inappropriate behaviors that would detract from a 6. positive image of the team or be detrimental to its performance objectives.
- All athletes will display proper respect and sportsmanship toward coaches, officials, 7. administrators, fellow competitors, and the public.
- All athletes will remain for the entire competition unless excused by Team Manager 8.
- All athletes will refrain from any cell phone use at aquatic center, team meetings and 9. designated quiet times.

If an athlete fails to comply with the Honor Code, they will be subject to disciplinary action which may include, but is not limited to, being barred from team activities. Any violation of the Code of Conduct may be referred to a Virginia Swimming Review Section upon the team's return.
