

VSI ATHLETE REPRESENTATIVE

Responsibilities of the Virginia Swimming Athlete Representative.

The Virginia Swimming Athlete Representative is the voice that speaks for all of the swimmers in the LSC. The Athletes' Representative is expected to maintain open lines of communication with VSI swimmers that will allow their opinions, suggestions, and the like to be heard and discussed.

There are also specific requirements expected of the VSI Athlete Representative:

- 1. The Representative must be a rising high school junior
- 2. The position of Athlete Representative is a two year term.
- 3. There are two Athlete Representative. One is the Junior Representative and the second is the Senior Representative. In you first year of the term you will be designated as the Junior Athlete Representative. In the second year of your term you will be designated as the Senior Athlete Representative.
- 4. Athlete Representatives are expected to attend all of following during their term of office:
 - a. All Virginia Swimming Senior Champs meets.
 - b. Approximately 7 Board of Directors meetings per year (usually 4 are done in person and 3 by telephone).
 - c. 2 House of Delegates meetings per year (same weekend as 2 of the Board of Directors meetings).
 - d. The annual Virginia Swimming Awards Celebration (usually in April).
 - e. The annual Eastern Zone meeting (2nd weekend in May).
 - f. The United States Aquatic Sports Convention (1 week in September).
- 5. The Athlete Representatives are expected to plan, organize, and run the yearly election for VSI Athletes Representative that occurs at the VSI Spring Senior Champs meet.
- 6. Organize the Athlete Representatives from each team,
