ELIGIBILITY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open to all Virginia Swimming athletes registered prior to the first day of the meet from the following teams: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ACAC, ACST, BRAC, CAST, CCA, CYAC, FUAC, GATR, HOKI, KFY, LASO, LY, NOVA, SCAT, SFY, SMAC, STRM, VAST, YMST The qualifying period for this meet is January 1, 2016 through July 13, 2017 No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted. 8 and younger swimmers may compete in any 8 and under event regardless of their time. 8 and younger swimmers may compete in any 10 and under event in which they have a time that is slower than the age group championship qualifying time. 14 and younger swimmers may compete in any event in which they have a time that is slower than the age group championship qualifying time. 15 and older swimmers may compete in any event in which they have a time that is slower than the senior championship qualifying time. Age on July 14, 2017 will determine age for the entire meet. 10, 12, & 14 year old swimmers aging up from July 14 to July 20, 2017 with times too fast to qualify for this championship will be allowed to compete under the following conditions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any 10 or 12 year old swimmer who does not qualify in their new age group at Age Group Champs may enter the event. Any 14 year swimmer who does not qualify for Senior Champs may enter the event 10, 12, & 14 year old swimmers aging up between championships will be seeded correctly by time, however will swim exhibition only, and will not be eligible to receive an award. 						
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition. 						
FORMAT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All Events will be timed finals. 12 and younger swimmers will swim in the morning sessions 13 and older swimmers will swim in the afternoon sessions Overhead or Chase Starts may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee. 						
WARM-UP:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Morning sessions: Warm-ups at 7:00AM; competition starts not before at 8:20AM. Afternoon sessions: Warm-ups not before 12:00PM; competition starts not before 1:00PM. Distance session (800 Free): The pool will be opened for 15 min. of open warm-ups immediately

ENTRIES:	<p>DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS MONDAY, JULY 3, 2017.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Conforming and Non-Conforming times will be used for entry – Long Course Meters then Short Course Meters then Short Course Yards using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet. ● Teams submit entries via e-mail. ● A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the VSI meet summary sheet (available at VSI website, www.virginiaswimming.org) with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted. ● Swimmer may enter a maximum of 9 individual events, no more than 3 per day. ● “No Time” (NT) entries will be accepted. ● The Meet Director reserves the right to combine heats and events, which actions may require reseeding. ● Proof of Entry time, if requested, must be provided to the Age Group Chair within two (2) weeks of the request. Times not satisfactorily proved in that length of time will be considered non-verifiable and a fine will be assessed. ● Email entries to: Greg Lake glake@ccamarlins.com ● Late entries will be accepted. All late entries must submit proof of time. If received prior to the printing of the heat sheet, the swimmer will be seeded into the event; if after, he/she will go in the slowest heat in an empty lane. If needed, a heat will be added.

AWARDS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Individual events will be scored and awarded medals for first (1st) through third (3rd) place, and ribbons, fourth (4th) through sixteenth (16th) place. ● Individual 13 and Over events will be awarded as 13-14 and 15 and Over.
SEEDING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Event #s 17, 18, 25, 26, 45, 46, 47, 48, 57, 58, 87 & 88 will require a positive check-in to swim. All other events will be pre-seeded. ● Positive check-in will close at 8:30AM Friday for event #17-18. ● Positive check-in will close at 1:00PM Friday, for event #25-26. ● Positive check-in will close at 8:30AM Saturday, for event #47-48.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Positive check-in will close at 1:00PM Saturday, for event #57-58. • Positive check-in will close at 1:00PM Sunday, for event #87-88. • Swimmers failing to positively check-in will not be allowed to swim the event. • Events 87 & 88 (800 Freestyle) will be swum fastest to slowest and alternating heats of girls and boys.
PENALTIES:	<p>Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded. • Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results. • Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming before the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered. • If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer. • A swimmer who positively checks-in and declares their intent to swim for a distance event and does not show up to compete will not be able to swim his/her next event.
RULES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. • Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval. • Any swimmer entered in the meet must be dive certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. • Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>. • Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited. • In accordance with VSI Best Practices, swimmers should shower before entering the pool • In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Coaches who have valid USA Swimming credentials but who are unable to provide them upon request will be issued temporary credentials by the meet director ○ Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

TIMERS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clubs will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session. • The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be posted on the Marlins website, no later than Tuesday, July 11, 2017, and will also be emailed to the contact person of each of the individual clubs. • Swimmers are expected to provide their own timers and lap counters for Events 87 & 88 (13 & Over 800 Freestyle)
