ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TUESDAY, APRIL 23, 2019.
	• Entries must be submitted in long course meter times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet.
	Teams should submit entries via email.
	• A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries.
	• All entry times other than Coach Time (CT) must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. CT entries and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT must be slower than an A time.
	• All Swimmers may enter a maximum of 2 individual events on the Friday Session.
	• Swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 individual events per session but no more than 4 total for the day on Saturday or Sunday to allow them to swim in the distance session.
	• Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.
	• The 800 Freestyle will be limited to 7 heats (up to 63 swimmers) for each gender.
	• The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events which may require reseeding.
	 If any session timeline is shorter than normal, additional time between events may be added at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

PENALTIES:	• A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet: Illegal participation is defined as:
	Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times.
	Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.
	Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.
	• If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
	Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
	• Any swimmer entered into the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When accompanied by a member coach, the swimmer's legal guardian must ensure compliance with this requirement.
	• Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u> .
	• Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in the locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is PROHIBITED.
	• Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.
	• In accordance with VSI Best Practices, swimmers should shower before entering the pool.
	• In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
