	• The 50-Meter competition pool with bulkhead offers two 25 yard competition pools with a depth of seven feet and seven inches at the sides and eight feet two inches in the center. Competition lanes are a minimum of 9 feet wide swum wall to bulkhead.				
	This meet will be swum in the 50 METER course.

ELIGIBILITY:	 Open to all SwimRVA and WAC athletes who are registered with USA Swimming before the fiday of the meet. Age on August 8 will determine age for the entire meet.

SCREENING, CHECK-IN and	• All athletes and parents need to report to the screening station upon arrival. Parents will receive a wrist band once they are screened. Athletes will be checked in for the meet.				
WARM-UP:	SWIMMERS FAILING TO REPORT TO THE SCREENING STATION WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT. MINOR ATHLETES WILL NEED TO REPORT TO THE SCREENING STATION WITH A PARENT OR GUARDIAN. 	• Morning session: Athlete screening and Check-in at 7:00-8:15AM under the tent in the front lawn of the facility. Warm-ups at 7:40-8:10 for SwimRVA and 8:20-8:50 for WAC, athletes will have assigned lanes and should wait to report to their assigned warm up lane until 7:35 and 8:15AM respectively; competition starts at 9:00AM.				
	 Late morning/afternoon session: Athlete screening and Check-in NOT BEFORE at 12:30-1:40PM under the tent in the front lawn of the facility. Warm-ups NOT BEFORE 1:10-1:40 for SwimRVA and 1:50-2:20PM for WAC, athletes will have assigned lanes and should wait to report to their assigned warm up lane until 1:15PM and 1:45PM respectively; competition starts at 2:30PM. 				
	 If the morning session runs late, afternoon check in will begin 30 minutes after conclusion of the morning session to give staff time to disinfect the facility. 				
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS Friday, July 31 at 5PM.				
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of <i>4 individual event(s)</i> .				
	 Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit. 				
	 Athletes may swim EITHER the 400 Free or the 400 IM, but not both. 				
	No deck entries will be accepted.

Spectators, athletes, coaches and officials not in the same household need to maintain 10 feet of social distance while outside the venue. SwimRVA will have speakers with the arena PA in the outdoor seating area. The announcer will announce heats and events. The announcer will also call athletes to the arena for their event when three heats prior to the race in the water.

STARTING	THERE WILL BE NO INDOOR SEATING					
BLOCKS	 REPORTING TO THE STARTING BLOCKS: SwimRVA will have speakers with the arena publi address in the outdoor seating area. The announcer will announce heats and events. The announcer will also call athletes to the arena for their event three heats in front of their race. Athletes should report to the arena through the northeast entry doors and ready themselves in the corresponding location on the north wall. Heat in the water, next heat on deck at the northwest corner of the competition pool, second heat in the next wait zone, third heat in the ne wait zone. It is the athlete's responsibility to report to the blocks and corresponding location when it is time to compete. 					
SEEDING:	Heat sheets will be distributed electronically at no cost.

AWARDS:	Awards will not be distributed. Scoring will be broken out by age group.					
PENALTIES:	 A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as 					
	 Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. 					
	• Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.					
	• Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.					
	 If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer. 					
	Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.					
RULES:	Athletes must arrive in their suits. Locker rooms will not be available.					
	 All individuals entering the facility will be expected to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions to include temperature screening 					
	 Lobby restrooms and Swim and Tri swim shop are open for anyone wearing a mask and able to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions. 					
	Coaches, officials, and spectators must wear masks.

	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. 					
	 Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval. 					
	 Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>. 					
	 Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED. 					
	 An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider.

TIMERS:	• There will be one timer assigned per lane. Timer shifts will be assigned based on entries and the length of each session. Timer brief will take place 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet. Timers should walk around the outside of the building to the east competition pool entry doors. (SEE MAP)			
GENERAL:	 Swim and Tri swim shop will be available in the lobby. Hospitality will be limited to water and prepackaged snacks. There will not be concessions offered at the contest. 			
FACILITY RULES:	No glass containers of any kind are permitted in the facility No spectators/parents will be allowed on deck unless working the meet. No smoking is allowed on the campus All rules are posted pool side
